calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed.					
2. <b>Testing</b> : Prior to acceptance, the end user shall conduct a physical					
inspection and functionality test. The equipment must be functioning and					
must have no physical damage and defect.					
3. <b>Training</b> : The supplier shall provide a training on the proper use and					
maintenance of the equipment to the end-users and to the hospital					
maintenance staff within 3 days upon delivery of the equipment.
