<p><u>B. REQUIREMENTS IF AWARDED THE CONTRACT</u></p> <p>1. Completion Period: The delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of the equipment and its accessories, including the training of end-users and maintenance staff must be completed with 30 calendar days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed.</p> <p>2. Testing: Prior to acceptance, the end user shall conduct a physical inspection and functionality test. The equipment must be functioning and must have no physical damage and defect.</p> <p>3. Training: The supplier shall provide a training on the proper use and maintenance of the equipment to the end-users and to the hospital maintenance staff within 3 days upon the delivery of the equipment.</p> <p>4. Warranty: Warranty certificate for two (2) years on parts and service. The supplier shall either repair or replace any item or part in the equipment that is found to be defective in material or in workmanship under normal use. The warranty period shall commence from the date of acceptance by the end-user after testing and commissioning.</p> <p>5. Notarized undertaking that the supplier shall conduct the necessary corrective maintenance within five (5) calendar days upon notification of the equipment</p>
