A weekly disease surveillance update of the DOH – NCRO Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit

OTHER DISEASES MONITORED

Acute Bloody Diarrhea

There were 26 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **64% lower** compared to the same period last year (73). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 9 months to 68 years old (median 9.5 years). Majority of cases 14 (54%) were male; and 10 (38%) were positive for *Entamoeba Histolytica*. Majority of the positive cases 3 (30%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

Acute Encephalitis Syndrome

There were 47 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **34% higher** compared to the same period last year (35). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 77 years old (median 10 years). Majority of cases 25 (53%) were male. Majority of the cases 25 (53%) were from Manila. One (CFR 2.13) death was reported.

Bacterial Meningitis

There were 141 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **5% lower** compared to the same period last year (149). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 80 years old (median 1 year). Majority of cases 72 (51%) were male. Most of the cases 41 (29%) were from Quezon City. Seven (CFR 4.96) deaths were reported.

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

There were 81 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **58% lower** compared to the same period last year (195). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 29 years old (median 2 year). Majority of cases 47 (58%) were male. Most of the cases 31 (38%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

Hepatitis A

There were 15 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **46% lower** compared to the same period last year (28). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 2 months to 81 years old (median 29 years). Majority of cases 10 (67%) were male. Majority of the cases 7 (47%) were from Manila. There was no death reported.

Hepatitis B

There were 113 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **33% lower** compared to the same period last year (169). There were 3 admissions for this week. Ages of cases

ranged from 4 months to 64 years old (median 31 years). Majority of cases 82 (73%) were female. Most of the cases 36 (32%) were from Manila. Two (CFR 1.8) deaths were reported.

Hepatitis C

There was 1 confirmed case admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **83% lower** compared to the same period last year (6). There was no admission for this week. Age of the case was 13 years old, male admitted last February 18, 2018 at Medical Center Manila from Manila.

Influenza-like Illness

There were 659 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **48% higher** compared to the same year last year (444). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 86 years old (median 9 years). Majority of cases 335 (51%) were male. Most of the cases 248 (38%) were from Quezon City. One (CFR 0.2) death was reported.

Malaria

There were 7 confirmed uncomplicated cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases are 25 to 54 years old (median 34 years). 6 (86%) cases were male. Cases had travel history to Brazil, South Africa, Equatorial Guinea, Sudan, France and Africa area based on the investigation done by respective LGU surveillance officers. Cases were positive for Falciparum and Malariae.

Meningococemia

There were 6 confirmed admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were 5 months to 19 years old (median 1.5 years). Majority of cases 4 (67%) were female. Most of the cases 4 (67%) were from Quezon City. One (CFR 16.7) death was reported.

Non-neonatal Tetanus

There were 30 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **44% lower** compared to the period last year (54). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 to 87 years old (median 41.5 years). Majority of cases 21 (70%) were male. Most of the cases 10 (33%) were from the cities of Manila and Quezon. Five (CFR 16.7) deaths were reported.

Rabies

There were 7 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. There is **22% lower** compared to the same period last year (9). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were ranged from 8 to 72 years old (median 37 years). Majority of the cases 4 (57%) were from Cities of Caloocan and Quezon City. Seven (CFR 100) deaths were reported. All of the cases were bitten by dog both stray and domestic.


Typhoid and Paratyphoid Fever

There were 191 cases admitted from January 1 to June 23, 2018. This is **20% lower** compared to the same period last year (238). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 86 years old (median 14 years). Majority of cases 96 (50%) were female. Most of the cases 67 (35%) were from Quezon City. Three (CFR 1.6) deaths were reported.

No case for the following diseases was reported:

- Cholera
- Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning


