



OTHER DISEASES MONITORED

Acute Bloody Diarrhea

There were 24 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **64% lower** compared to the same period last year (66). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 9 months to 68 years old (median 9.5 years). Majority of cases 14 (58%) were male; and 10 (42%) were positive for *Entamoeba Histolytica*. Majority of the positive cases 3 (30%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

Acute Encephalitis Syndrome

There were 45 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **36% higher** compared to the same period last year (33). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 77 years old (median 10 years). Majority of cases 24 (53%) were male. Majority of the cases 23 (51%) were from Manila. One (CFR 2.3) death was reported.

Bacterial Meningitis

There were 131 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **6% lower** compared to the same period last year (140). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 80 years old (median 1 year). Majority of cases 66 (50%) were male. Most of the cases 40 (31%) were from Quezon City. Five (CFR 3.8) deaths were reported.

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

There were 73 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **59% lower** compared to the same period last year (178). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 29 years old (median 2 year). Majority of cases 42 (58%) were male. Most of the cases 27 (37%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

Hepatitis A

There were 13 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **52% lower** compared to the same period last year (27). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 2 months to 60 years old (median 29 years). Majority of cases 10 (71%) were male. Majority of the cases 7 (50%) were from Manila. There was no death reported.

Hepatitis B

There were 106 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **32% lower** compared to the same period last year (155). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 4 months to 64 years old (median 31 years). Majority of cases 77 (73%) were female. Most of the cases 34 (32%) were from Manila. Two (CFR 1.9) deaths were reported.

Hepatitis C

There was 1 confirmed case admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **83% lower** compared to the same period last year (6). There was no admission for this week. Age of the case was 13 years old, male admitted last February 18, 2018 at Medical Center Manila from Manila.

Influenza-like Illness

There were 628 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **56% higher** compared to the same year last year (403). There were 3 admissions for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 86 years old (median 9 years). Majority of cases 321 (51%) were male. Most of the cases 241 (38%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported..

Leptospirosis

There were 91 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **28% lower** compared to the same time period last year (126). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 4 to 67 years old (median 38 years). Majority of cases 77 (85%) were male. Most of the cases 39 (43%) were from Quezon City. Sixteen (CFR 17.6) deaths were reported.

Malaria

There were 5 confirmed uncomplicated cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases are 39 to 54 years old (median 41 years). 5 (100%) cases were male. Cases had travel history to Brazil, South Africa, Equatorial Guinea and Sudan area based on the investigation done by respective LGU surveillance officers. Cases were positive for Falciparum and Malariae.

Meningococccemia

There were 6 confirmed admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were 5 months to 19 years old (median 1.5 years). Majority of cases 4 (67%) were female. Mast of the cases 4 (67%) were from Quezon City. One (CFR 16.7) death was reported.

Non-neonatal Tetanus

There were 24 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **49% lower** compared to the period last year (47). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 to 82 years old (median 42.5 years). Majority of cases 18 (75%) were male. Most of the cases 5 (21%) were from the city of Manila. Two (CFR 8.3) deaths were reported.

Rabies

There were 7 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. There is **13% lower** compared to the same period last year (8). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were ranged from 8 to 68 years old (median 37 years). Most of the cases 4 (57%) were from Cities of Caloocan and Quezon City. Seven (CFR 100) deaths were reported. All of the cases were bitten by dog both stray and domestic.

Typhoid and Paratyphoid Fever

There were 176 cases admitted from January 1 to June 9, 2018. This is **19% lower** compared to the same period last year (218). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 86 years old (median 14 years). Majority of cases 89 (51%) were male. Most of the cases 64 (36%) were from Quezon City. Three (CFR 1.7) deaths were reported.
