OTHER DISEASES MONITORED

Acute Bloody Diarrhea

There were 22 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **63% lower** compared to the same period last year (59). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 to 68 years old (median 9.5 years). Majority of cases 12 (55%) were male; and 9 (41%) were positive for *Entamoeba Histolytica*. Majority of the positive cases 3 (33%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

Acute Encephalitis Syndrome

There were 37 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **16% higher** compared to the same period last year (32). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 77 years old (median 6). Majority of cases 19 (51%) were male. Majority of the cases 20 (54%) were from Manila. There was no death reported.

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

There were 72 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **57% lower** compared to the same period last year (168). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 29 years old (median 2 year). Majority of cases 41 (57%) were male. Most of the cases 25 (35%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

Hepatitis A

There were 11 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **52% lower** compared to the same period last year (23). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 2 months to 60 years old (median 29 years). Majority of cases 7 (64%) were male. Most of the cases 5 (46%) were from Manila. There was no death reported.

Hepatitis B

There were 95 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **35% lower** compared to the same period last year (146). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 4 months to 64 years old (median 31 years). Majority of cases 70 (74%) were female. Most of the cases 30 (32%) were from Manila. Two (CFR 2.1) deaths were reported.

Hepatitis C

There was 1 confirmed case admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **83% lower** compared to the same period last year (6). There was no admission for this week. Age of the case was 13 years old, male admitted last February 18, 2018 at Medical Center Manila from Manila.

Influenza-like Illness

There were 593 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **63% higher** compared to the same year last year (363). There were 3 admissions for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 86 years old (median 9 years). Majority of cases 298 (50%) were male. Most of the cases 228 (38%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported..

Leptospirosis

There were 86 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **25% lower** compared to the same time period last year (115). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 9 to 67 years old (median 45 years). Majority of cases 72 (84%) were male. Most of the cases 37 (43%) were from the city of Quezon. Fourteen (CFR 16.3) deaths were reported.

Malaria

There were 2 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases are 31 and 45 years old. All of cases 2 (100%) were male. One of the cases had travel history to Endemic area based on the investigation done by respective LGU surveillance officers. Cases were positive for Falciparum and Malariae.

Meningitis Bacterial

There were 113 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **10% lower** compared to the same period last year (126). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 80 years old (median 1 year). Majority of cases 57 (50%) were male. Most of the cases 38 (34%) were from Quezon City. Four (CFR 3.5) deaths were reported.

Meningococccemia

There were 6 confirmed admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were 5 months to 19 years old (median 1.5 years). Majority of cases 4 (67%) were female. Mast of the cases 4 (67%) were from Quezon City. One (CFR 16.7) death was reported.

Non-neonatal Tetanus

There were 21 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **51% lower** compared to the period last year (43). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 to 67 years old (median 41 years). Majority of cases 17 (81%) were male. Most of the cases 4 (27%) were from the Manila. Two (CFR 9.52) deaths were reported.

Rabies

There were 6 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. There is **14% lower** compared to the same period last year (7). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were ranged from 8 to 68 years old (median 34.5). Most of the cases 2 (33%) were from Quezon City. Six (CFR 100) deaths were reported. All of the cases were bitten by dog both stray and domestic.

Typhoid and Paratyphoid Fever

There were 166 cases admitted from January 1 to May 26, 2018. This is **20% lower** compared to the same period last year (208). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 86 years old (median 13 years). Majority of cases 85 (51%) were female. Most of the cases 64 (39%) were from Quezon City. Three (CFR 1.8) deaths were reported.

No case for the following diseases was reported:

- Cholera
- Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning


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
