January 1 - June 2, 2018

#### OTHER DISEASES MONITORED

## **Acute Bloody Diarrhea**

There were 22 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **65% lower** compared to the same period last year (63). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 to 68 years old (median 9.5 years). Majority of cases 12 (55%) were male; and 9 (41%) were positive for *Entamoeba Histolytica*. Majority of the positive cases 3 (33%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

#### **Acute Encephalitis Syndrome**

There were 45 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **36% higher** compared to the same period last year (33). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 77 years old (median 10 years). Majority of cases 24 (53%) were male. Majority of the cases 23 (51%) were from Manila. One (CFR 2.3) death was reported.

## Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

There were 73 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **58% lower** compared to the same period last year (175). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 29 years old (median 2 year). Majority of cases 42 (58%) were male. Most of the cases 26 (36%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported.

## **Hepatitis A**

There were 13 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **50% lower** compared to the same period last year (26). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 2 months to 60 years old (median 29 years). Majority of cases 9 (62%) were male. Majority of the cases 7 (54%) were from Manila. There was no death reported.

# **Hepatitis B**

There were 103 confirmed cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **32% lower** compared to the same period last year (151). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 4 months to 64 years old (median 31 years). Majority of cases 76 (74%) were female. Most of the cases 31 (30%) were from Manila. Two (CFR 1.9) deaths were reported.

# **Hepatitis C**

There was 1 confirmed case admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **83% lower** compared to the same period last year (6). There was no admission for this week. Age of the case was 13 years old, male admitted last February 18, 2018 at Medical Center Manila from Manila.

## Influenza-like Illness

There were 611 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **60% higher** compared to the same year last year (383). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 86 years old (median 9 years). Majority of cases 308 (50%) were male. Most of the cases 235 (39%) were from Quezon City. There was no death reported..

# Leptospirosis

There were 87 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **28% lower** compared to the same time period last year (120). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 4 to 67 years old (median 38 years). Majority of cases 73 (84%) were male. Most of the cases 38 (44%) were from Quezon City. Fourteen (CFR 16.3) deaths were reported.

#### Malaria

There were 5 confirmed uncomplicated cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases are 39 to 54 years old (median 41 years). 5 (100%) cases were male. Cases had travel history to Brazil, South Africa, Equatorial Guinea and Sudan area based on the investigation done by respective LGU surveillance officers. Cases were positive for Falciparum and Malariae.

## **Meningitis Bacterial**

There were 123 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **8% lower** compared to the same period last year (134). There were 4 admissions for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 month to 80 years old (median 1 year). Majority of cases 63 (51%) were male. Most of the cases 38 (31%) were from Quezon City. Five (CFR 4.1) deaths were reported.

## Meningococcemia

There were 6 confirmed admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were 5 months to 19 years old (median 1.5 years). Majority of cases 4 (67%) were female. Mast of the cases 4 (67%) were from Quezon City. One (CFR 16.7) death was reported.

## **Non-neonatal Tetanus**

There were 23 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **49% lower** compared to the period last year (45). There was one admission for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 1 to 71 years old (median 42 years). Majority of cases 18 (78%) were male. Most of the cases 8 (35%) were from the cities of Caloocan and Manila. Two (CFR 9.1) deaths were reported.

#### **Rabies**

There were 6 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. There is **25% lower** compared to the same period last year (8). There was no admission for this week. Ages of cases were ranged from 8 to 68 years old (median 34.5). Most of the cases 2 (33%) were from Quezon City. Six (CFR 100) deaths were reported. All of the cases were bitten by dog both stray and domestic.

#### Typhoid and Paratyphoid Fever

There were 173 cases admitted from January 1 to June 2, 2018. This is **18% lower** compared to the same period last year (212). There were 2 admissions for this week. Ages of cases ranged from 5 months to 86 years old (median 13 years). Majority of cases 87 (50%) were female. Most of the cases 65 (38%) were from Quezon City. Three (CFR 1.7) deaths were reported.
