



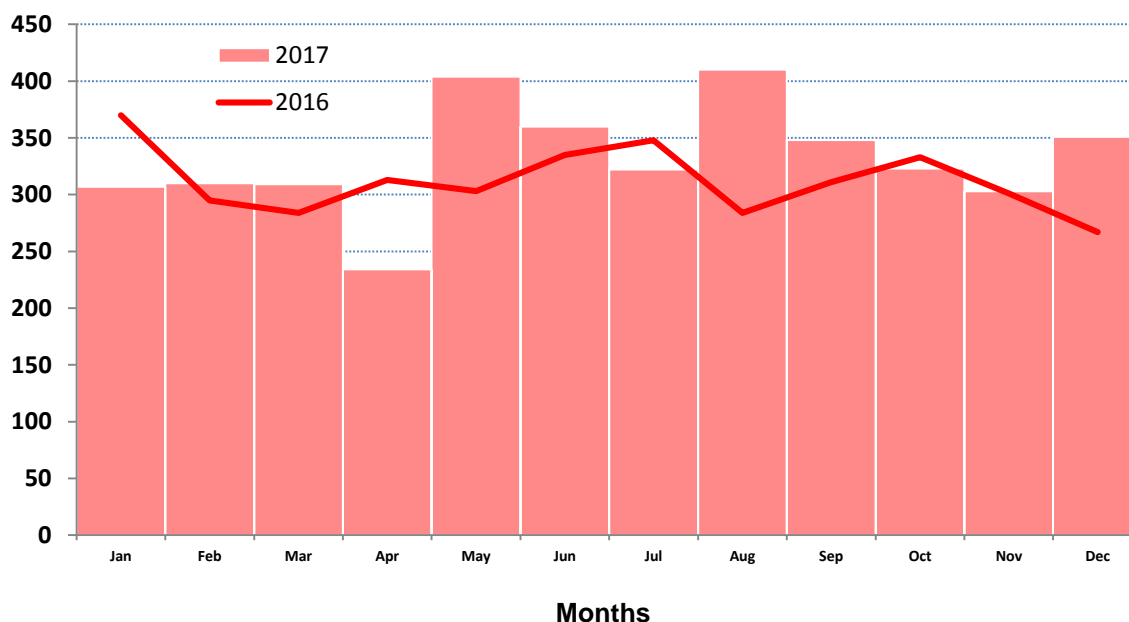
HIV/AIDS Cases in the National Capital Region

FINDINGS: Partial reports showed that there were 3,981 cases confirmed by the STD/AIDS Cooperative Central Laboratory (SACCL) and reported to the HIV/AIDS Registry from January 1 to December 31, 2017. This is 6% higher compare to same period last year (3,744) [Figure 1]. Majority 3,502 (88%) were asymptomatic (Table 1).

Most 2,454 (62%) were acquired through male-to-male sexual practices (Figure 2). 242 (6%) were OFWs (Table2).

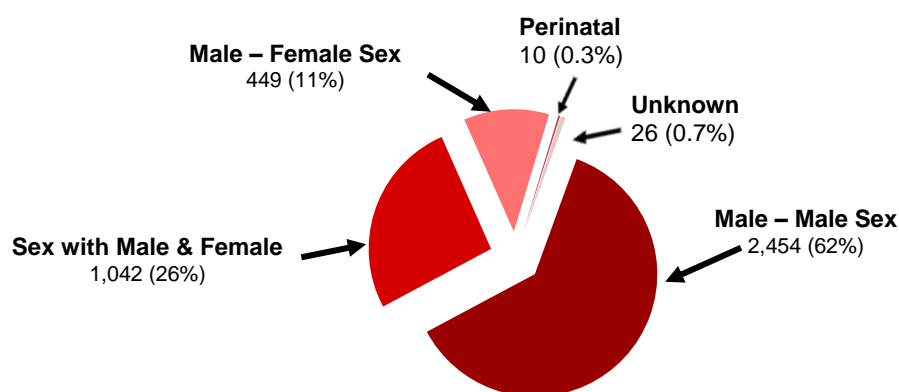

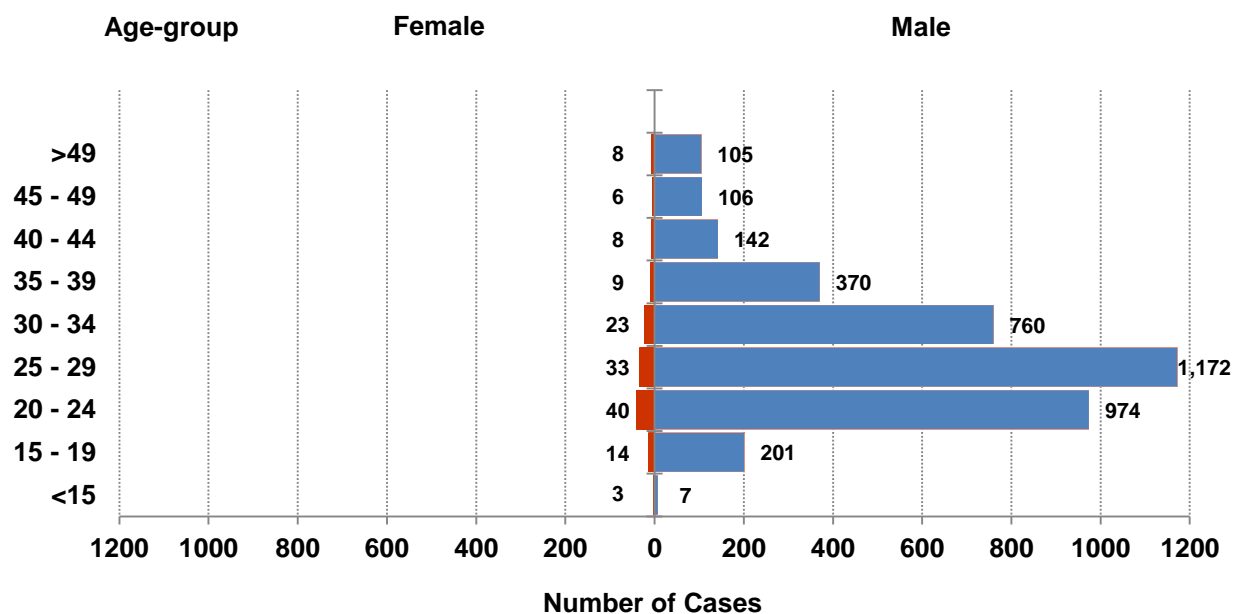

PROFILE OF CASES

Ages of cases ranged from 1 year to 79 years old (median 28 years). 1,205 (30%) of those affected were under the 25 - 29 years age-group (Figure 3). Majority 3,837 (96%) were male.

National Capital Region, January – December 2017



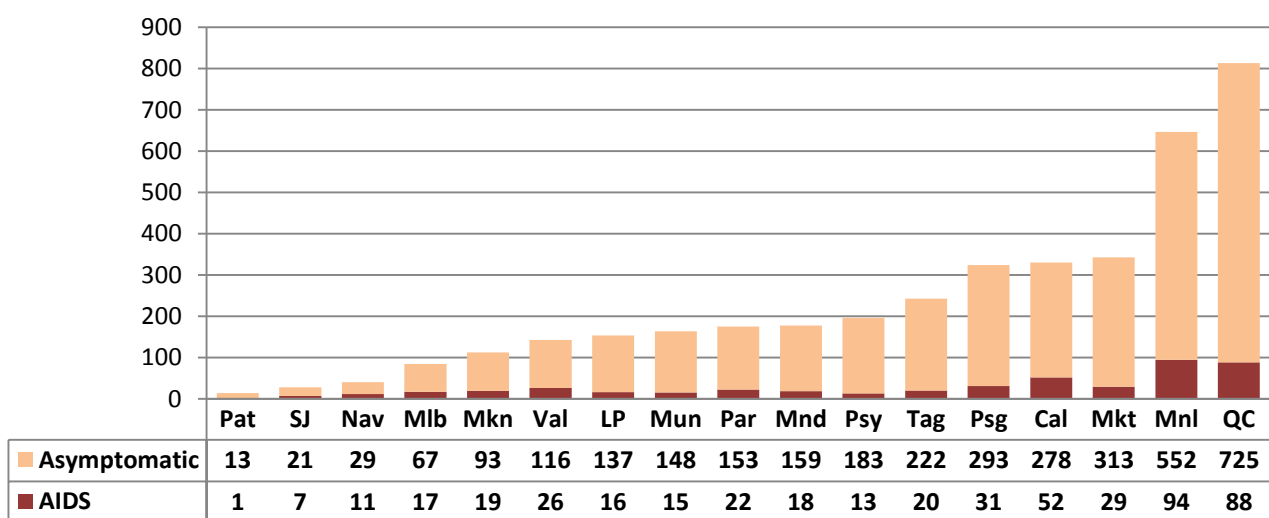
GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

Quezon City had 725 (18%) asymptomatic cases reported while Manila City had 94 (2%) AIDS cases (Figure 4). From January to December 2017 a total of 176 (CFR 4%) deaths were reported.

CUMULATIVE PROFILE (1984 – 2017)

A total of 20,878 cases had been reported from 1984 to present. Majority 19,097 (92%) was asymptomatic. Ages ranged from 1 year to 81 years old (median 28 years). Most 6,803 (33%) of those affected were under the 25 - 29 years age group. Majority (20,015 or 97%) were male. 11,539 (55%) were acquired through homosexual practices. 1,885 (9%) were OFWs. Eight hundred seventy-three (CFR 4%) deaths were reported.




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
